## Additional Information:

- 10. The Kasson Public School was constructed in 1917-1918. The architect was Nels S. Jacabson Jr. . The engineer was Frank Tustison Co., Mpls. The builder was Madsen and Peterson. It is neoclassical in design and consists of three 2-story conjoined buildings that occupy an entire city block. The exterior is pressed brick trimmed with terra cotta coping, cornice and roofs. The condition is good to very good, with no additions and alterations to windows and doors only. The interior is fair to deteriorated with updates, yet many original features and architectural components exist.
- 11. The city of Kasson now owns the property and is collecting bids for demolition.
- 12. We are trying to prove that the community was confused, uninformed and the vast majority prefer to save it and re-use,.
- 13. The school was built in the same year as Kasson's Municipal Building which is on the National Register. (Now privately owned and on Main Street, thriving as a commercial offices building) Other significance as to the year the school was built would be this country's involvement in WW1. We haven't had time to research beyond this.
- 14. If there is opposition to preserving this school, it appears to be coming from the city council.
- 15. If this school were placed on the endangered list, the entire community would understand the real value of this building, it might sway the city council to rethink their actions and if necessary, being on the list might give our group leverage if we litigate.
- 16. Our next step is to file a citizens petition for an Environmental Assessment Worksheet to be prepared. And we will be seeking legal advice.
- 17. We have received great advice from Bonnie McDonald and your Crisis Handbook has become our bible! We are anxious for any guidance or recommendations from you.
- 18. The Kasson city council is hiding behind the failed referendum on the November ballot. We have approached them with a clear vision and proper arguments, We have presented them TWO interested buyers of the property. (Whose interest is in adaptive re-use. These people are already invested in Kasson!) The city council shows no interest and has ended the debate.
